

SEAS Monmouth Raft Up Policy

(Share your boat and have some fun)

The PRIMARY purpose of raft ups is to provide chapter members who do not own their own boats an opportunity to sail on larger boats, and to socialize with other members.

Raft ups are made possible by the generosity of those chapter members who own boats and welcome other members on board for the day.

When a boat-owning member decides to attend an upcoming raft up, he/she will advise the raft up coordinator. The boat owner will be free to bring along other people of his/her own choice, providing spaces on board their boat are made available to the coordinator for chapter members who wish to participate.

The chapter-owned boat (Invictus) will also participate in the raft up. The skipper will be one of the chapter's skippers, qualified to sail the boat in the area of the particular raft up. There will be no charge for anyone sailing on Invictus for the raft up.

Any member who wishes to attend the raft up as a crew member, will contact the coordinator, in advance of the raft up date. The coordinator will work with skippers to place members in a way that will ensure an enjoyable day for all.

The coordinator will facilitate communications between the skippers to determine the location and time for the raft-up.

Each boat-owner/skipper will make his/her own arrangements directly with the crew regarding time and place of departure, etc. Each participant is responsible for his/her own food and drink.
